Joint Committee on Pensions Update Anne Gawthrop, Director of Legislative Affairs, provided an update from the Joint Committee on Pensions. The Committee unanimously agreed to sponsor all the Board's legislative proposals.

Ms. Gawthrop also informed the Board that the Joint Committee on Pensions voted to sponsor legislation to exclude any increase in compensation from being considered an extraordinary salary increase if the increase was related to a review and adjustment to the compensation for a position classification.

Chief Investment Officer's Report Mr. Burd provided the Board with two fund tear sheets and reported that the final October performance was -1.71% for the month and -3.50% fiscal year to date, with a market value of \$62.2 billion. The benchmark was down -4.15% fiscal year to date. For November, the preliminary performance for the month was +4.26% with a total fund value of \$64.6 billion. The preliminary fiscal year to date return through November was +0.61%. Mr. Burd also reported that the strong returns in November had carried over into December, which will result in higher returns and market value for month end.

Executive Director's Report

Mr. Noven thanked Michael Golden, External Affairs Director, for 34 years of service with the State of Maryland and acknowledged his approaching retirement.

FY2023 System Active Membership The Board was presented with the System's active membership by percentage employed by the State, the local public libraries, and each participating local employer as of June 30 of the second prior fiscal year. The certified percentages are provided to determine each System employer's pro rata share of the administrative and operational expenses of the Board of Trustees and the State Retirement Agency for the fiscal year. This report serves as certification of the System's active membership as of the end of the fiscal year and is submitted to the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management in accordance with State Personnel and Pensions Article § 21-316(c) of the Maryland Annotated Code.

On a motion made by Doug Prouty and seconded by Mr. Norman, the Board voted to recertify the required membership percentages.

On a motion made by Ms. English-Brown and seconded by Mr. Daly, the Board voted to meet in a Closed Session, beginning at 1:19 p.m., via a WebEx video/audio conference call, for the purposes of:
