Board Requested Legislation Ms. Gawthrop presented the following four legislative proposals for the 2024 legislative session to the Administrative Committee for their review.

- > Repealing the Requirement to Produce Personal Statement of Benefits
- Technical Changes for COLA Provisions and 7-year DROP
- Reemployment of Retired Sheriffs
- ➤ Title 37 Clean-up

On a motion made by Mr. Sandlass and seconded by Ms. Allen, the Administrative Committee voted unanimously to recommend these four proposals to the Board for their review and recommendation to present each to the Joint Committee on Pensions.

Ms. Gawthrop also presented the issue regarding how extraordinary salary increases are handled for pension purposes to the Administrative Committee. Because this is a policy issue with a potential fiscal impact to the State, Ms. Gawthrop did not propose a specific action on this issue, but instead recommended bringing the issue to the Joint Committee on Pensions for the Joint Committee to determine if any changes to the existing policy should be made.

On a motion made by Mr. Sandlass and seconded by Ms. Allen, the Administrative Committee voted 6-1 to recommend Ms. Gawthrop's proposal to the Board of Trustees for their review and recommendation to forward this issue to the Joint Committee on Pensions. Mr. Nicole opposed the motion.
