information; and General Provisions Art., Section 3-305(b)(14), to discuss, before a contract is awarded, a matter directly related to a negotiating strategy or the contents of a bid or proposal, if public discussion or disclosure would adversely impact the ability of the public body to participate in the competitive bidding or proposal process; and

(c) discussing a personnel matter, pursuant to General Provisions Art., Section 3-305(b)(1)(i), the appointment, employment, assignment, promotion, discipline, demotion, compensation, removal, resignation, or performance evaluation of appointees, employees, or officials over whom it has jurisdiction.
